**1John 1:10** If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

**Romans 5:12** Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin;

and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

My note: How do we know for sure that sin is in the world? Because death is ever present and death is the result of sin so, sin is in us as is evident by death and sin is ever present in the world as is evident by death.

( My note: These are the words of Jesus: )

<u>Luke 15:10</u> Likewise I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God

### deserving of hell

( My note: These are the words of Jesus: )

Luke 16:19-31 vs. 22 "the rich man also died, and was buried;"

vs. 23 "And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments,"

vs. 24"for I am tormented in this flame."

vs. 25 "and thou art tormented."

vs. 28 "lest they also come into this place of torments."

#### <u>and then</u> being cast into the lake of fire and brimstone!

### To be tormented with Satan, the false prophet, the beast,

Revelation 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Revelation 20:1,2,3

1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan,

and bound him a thousand years,

3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him,

that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

( My note: Lucifer is the Devil and Satan, before he rebelled against the LORD. )

<u>Isaiah 14:12-15</u> 12 How art thou fallen from heaven, O <u>Lucifer</u>, son of the morning!

how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

13 For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:

14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

15 Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

Ezekiel 28:12-19 vs.12 "king of Tyrus,"

vs.14 "Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth;"

vs.15 "Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created,

till iniquity was found in thee."

vs.16 ": and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub,"

<u>My note</u>: <u>Death</u>, n. 9. In theology, perpetual separation from God, and eternal torments; called the second death. <u>Rev. 2:11</u>
<u>Die</u>, v.i. 10. In theology, to <u>perish</u> everlastingly, to suffer <u>divine</u> wrath and punishment in the future world. <u>Lk 15:24; Rev. 1:18</u>
Divine, a. Pertaining to the true God.

<u>Perish</u>, v.t. [...; literally, to depart wholly.] 10. To be lost eternally; to be sentenced to endless misery. <u>2Peter 2:12; John 3:16</u>

My note: All definitions are from Noah Webster's 1828 American Dictionary of the English Language

( My note: These words in bold print are the words of Jesus: )

Matthew 8:12 But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness:

there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 22:13 Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 24:51 50 The Lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of,

51 And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites:

there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

**Matthew 25:30** And cast ye the unprofitable servant into <u>outer darkness</u>:

there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

<u>Jude vs.6</u> And <u>the angels which kept not their first estate</u>, but left their own habitation, <u>he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.</u>

(My note: These words are the words of Jesus:)

<u>Matthew 25:40,41,46</u> 40 And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me. 41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, <u>Depart from me</u>, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels: 46 <u>And these shall go away into everlasting punishment</u>: but the righteous into life eternal.

#### and

### every one who is unworthy of Heaven.

**2Corinthians 5:10** For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.

**Revelation 20:12-15** 

12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

and the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

# This confession must be sincere; Just saying the words does not save any one from being cast away from the holiness of God, for ever!

( <u>My note</u>: The apostle Paul declaring himself as chief of sinners. )

### How do you know that you are a sinner?

( My note: Death is the result of sin. ) ( Read: Genesis 3:19,21 )

1Corinthians 15:21,22 21 For by man came death, ...

22 For as in Adam all die, ...

**Romans 3:23** For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

**Romans 8:6-8** 6 For to be carnally minded is death; ...

7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God:

for it is not subject to the law of God neither indeed can be.

8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

**<u>Hebrews 9:27</u>** And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

**Ezekiel 18:4** Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine:

the soul that sinneth, it shall die.

### Have you received <u>Jesus Christ</u> as your personal <u>Lord & Saviour</u>? Have you received <u>HIM</u>, <u>who paid the sin debt in full!</u>

1Peter 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins,

8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation?

for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

9 And <u>he made his grave with the wicked</u>, and with the rich <u>in his death</u>; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.

10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief:

when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

11 He shall see the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied:

by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

12 Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong;

because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors;

and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

My note: (face)

<u>his visage was so marred more than any man,</u>

My note: (body)

and his form more than the sons of men:

<u>Hebrews 9:28</u> So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

<u>Astonied</u> → <u>Astonished</u> → = put to shame and silence → <u>Dismayed</u> = deprived of mental courage <u>lacking all unterstanding!</u>

Read: 8:1-39; 15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear;

<u>Read</u>: 8:9,10,11 but <u>ye have received the Spirit of adoption</u>, <u>whereby we cry</u>, <u>Abba</u>, <u>Father</u>.

16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ;

if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life:

### no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

# If you have truly received Jesus Christ as your personal Lord & Saviour and

### if you have truly received the Holy Spirit of God then,

### you are born again!

John 3:3-6
3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. 4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? 5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

My note: born of water refers to natural birth (of the flesh) & born of the Spirit refers to spiritual birth (of the Holy Spirit); "born again".

### **1Peter 1:23**

Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

### You are a child of God!

### You are not of this world but of the world to come! This is not your home!

<u>1Corinthians 13:12</u> For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: <u>now I know in part</u>; <u>but then shall I know even as also I am known.</u>

**Romans 7:24** 24 O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?

25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God;

but with the flesh the law of sin.

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Romans 8:16,17 16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit that we are children of God:

( <u>My note</u>: "the creature" is the body.)
